Dr. Heike Baumüller is a Senior Researcher and Coordinator of the Program of Accompanying Research for Agricultural Innovation (PARI) at the Centre for Development Research (ZEF) at the University of Bonn, Germany. Her research focuses on the role of information and communication technologies in facilitating agricultural innovation along agricultural value chains in developing countries. Prior to joining ZEF, she was a Senior Research Fellow with the Energy, Environment and Development Programme at Chatham House in London, studying the environmental and socio-economic dimensions of trade in natural resources. Previously, Dr. Baumüller coordinated the Environment and Natural Resources Programme and led the implementation of projects on fisheries and biotechnology at the International Centre for Trade and Sustainable Development (ICTSD) in Geneva. She holds a PhD in Agricultural Sciences from the University of Bonn, a Master of Environmental Studies from Macquarie University, Sydney, and a Bachelor in Cognitive Science from the University of Exeter, UK.
