

### **Prof. Dr. Harald Grethe**

Agricultural Economist, Humboldt University Berlin



Harald Grethe is Professor for International Agricultural Trade and Development at Humboldt-University of Berlin. Formerly, he was a Professor for Agricultural and Food Policy at the University of Hohenheim. He is a graduate of Georg-August University in Göttingen and Humboldt-University in Berlin, a co-author of the ESIM agricultural sector model and a founding member of the Expert Network for Agro-Economic Modelling (ENgAGE) at the European Commission. His research interests include the analysis of global biomass supply and use, economic and agricultural development, poverty, income distribution and food security, sustainable diets, and the interaction between water, energy and agriculture. Since 2012, Harald Grethe chairs the Scientific Advisory Board on Agricultural Policy, Food and Consumer Protection at the German Federal Ministry of Food and Agriculture and has worked as an expert for many national and international institutions among which the European Commission, OECD, FAO, the World Bank, and USDA.
